# Market Animal Exhibitor-Required Documents

## Drug Free Affidavit

It is the responsibility of all market exhibitors not to exhibit any animal that will still be within the medication withdrawal period on sale day. Any medication that must be administered during fair week can only be done by meeting all 3 of the following criteria:

1. Medication must be administered under a veterinarian's supervision.
2. All vet expenses will be assumed by the exhibitor.
3. The Junior Livestock Committee officers must be notified prior to medication being administered.

Any animal receiving medication with a withdrawal period then must be removed from the fair as soon as possible.

I have read and understand the regulation listed above and hereby agree to abide by the regulations. I declare that the market animal(s) I have entered in the Huntingdon County Fair have not received any drugs or treatment with biologics within the withdrawal time prior to slaughter.
