Section 1 - Homemade Wine

1. Enter online at entries.huntingdoncountyfair.com or send completed General Entry Form to the Fair Office by July 1.
2. Entries must be entered on Saturday, August 3, from 11-5 p.m. in Neary Hall.
3. ****NEW** All wine will be disposed of after judging. Wine exhibitors may pick up their opened bottles of wine by 1 p.m. on Sunday, August 4. If opened wine is picked up, the exhibitor may bring a new empty wine bottle to be displayed, or please bring a container for wine so the bottle can be displayed.**
4. Only 1 entry per class.
5. Wine entered for this competition must be amateur wine, home produced under regulations of Part 540 wine, Title 20 of the Code of Federal Regulations.
6. Wine may be drawn from any year's grapes and/or other fermentables but may not be re-entered in subsequent years.
7. All wines must be bottled in a 750 ml bottle and labeled as follows:

- Year of fermentation
- Name of wine
- Name of fermented component(s)
- Type of wine (white, red, etc.)

Wine will be judged on flavor, aroma, body, smell, finish, and overall impression.
